Home Reading

Many thanks to those of you who are completing your child's Reading Record form each week. Please make sure you have completed it once a week, by the end of Friday. The average time to complete our form is only two minutes so it should be quick and easy to do once a week.

Being a confident and fluent reader enables your child to succeed across the curriculum. Being read to also has a large impact on a child's comprehension skills.



COVID-19 reminder

All parents and carers have been sent a letter advising that a positive test result for a child must be reported using an [on-line form](#) which can be located on the home page of our school website.

If your child is being tested please let the office know in the usual way via the absence line. You should continue to report your child's absence in this way every day until you have the test results. If the test result is negative, please let the school office know prior to your child returning to school. Please remember, if anyone in your household has symptoms, you should all isolate until the result of the Covid test is known. If the result is positive you will all need to continue to isolate in line with national guidelines.

Flow chart for managing COVID-19 symptoms at home



If your child shows any COVID-19 symptoms they cannot return to school without receiving a Negative test

If you are contacted by NHS Test & Trace (and your child was with you during the contact with the COVID-19 person) you and your child must self-isolate for 14 days even if either of you receive a negative test.

If your child was not with you when you had contact with the positive person, your child can attend school as long as you do not develop symptoms.
