On Thursday, Pod 6 visited the STEAM Museum to take part in their 'We'll Meet Again' experience. The children went dressed as evacuees and took part in workshops on a variety of WWII themes: women in the war; the role of the railway in the war; evacuation; wartime memories and toys; and air-raid shelters. This was a great trip as the children got to enjoy hands-on activities and take part in drama and role-play. We were very proud of the children's excellent listening skills and their enthusiasm for the activities. After a museum volunteer shared his memories of life as a child in the war, he commented that **their behaviour was "impeccable"**, which was lovely to hear. We look forward to continuing our World War II topic back at school.
