Please see the Trust statement below regarding support for children with EHCPs during this third lockdown.

Remote learning and meetings during lockdown

Following DfE guidance all vulnerable pupils should attend school for face-to-face teaching and learning. Where this is not possible due to shielding or isolation, the Academy will provide remote learning. The Trust understands that remote learning can be difficult for some children and young people with SEND and can pose unique challenges for children and families. It is for this reason that we encourage all children with EHCPs to attend school during lockdown period.

Where remote learning is provided the Academy will communicate frequently with parents/carers and families to ensure continuous guidance and support. Bespoke remote learning will be personalised to individualised needs and may include on-line teaching and learning, on-line meetings, regular communication by telephone or email and bespoke learning packs

Meetings will continue during this time to keep IEP target meetings on track, hold Annual Reviews meetings and provide additional support where appropriate. Meetings will be by telephone or on-line.
